**SUBJECT: Grandfather Approval of Existing 30 x 56 pixel
SolarTech Silent Messenger PCMS**

This is in response to your memo dated October 30th, 2009 regarding grandfather approval of existing 30 x 56 SolarTech Silent Messenger PCMS. Per your memo, our understanding is that the signs to be grandfathered shall be upgraded to include the retro-reflective sign face border, a GPS, a compass and to meet the Ministry's NTCIP requirements. As custodian of the Ministry's Designated Source Materials (DSM) List item 6.30.21 – Electronic Highway Information: Portable Variable Message Signs, I accept the upgraded signs as DSM approved with the following caveats:

- This grandfathering acceptance only applies to the following signs as listed below:

- ***These signs are only approved for temporary use as described in SP 543F07*** – The signs can be used for temporary rental purposes on Ministry contracts, however, these signs are not acceptable for contracts where the signs become Ministry property at the end of the contract.
- ***These signs shall be labelled with the new designation MB-3056-MTO*** – The signs shall be labelled with the new designation to be consistent with the upcoming DSM approval and to ensure that they are considered acceptable under other Ministry contacts for temporary use.
